

AMP™ AND STS, INC
PRIVACY POLICY

June 1, 2009

1. Your Agreement to This Privacy Policy.

a. Solutions Through Software, Inc. (STS, Inc. is referred to as the “Company,” “we” or “us”) has adopted the following privacy policy relating to the Company’s Activities Management Portal™ (AMP™) Web Site (the “Web Site”), and we ask you to read it thoroughly. By accepting the Company’s Terms and Conditions of Web Site Use Agreement (“Terms of Use Agreement”) you are also accepting and agreeing to this Privacy Policy.

b. By using the services provided to you through the Web Site, you consent to the collection and use of your information as outlined in this Privacy Policy. The Company may change all or any part of this Privacy Policy without notice. If you use the Web Site after any changes to this Privacy Policy are posted, you are agreeing to those changes.

2. Helpful Definitions. The following definitions will be helpful to your understanding of this Privacy Policy:

a. "personally identifiable information" is information such as name, birth date, e-mail address or mailing address, financial information and other types of information that can be used to uniquely identify a user. Because of the nature of AMP™, personally identifiable information will also include information based on your Web Site activities, such as items or services offered or acquired, descriptions thereof, offers, counter offers and other communications with potential parties to a transaction. For paid postings, we will collect your name, telephone number, address and other relevant information, and we will collect and store credit card information if that is the method by which you pay, all of which will also constitute personally identifiable information; and

b. "anonymous information" is information that does not personally identify you. This includes information on how you use the Web Site. Anonymous information also includes the domain names and/or IP addresses (as explained in greater detail below) of browsers that visit the Web Site, time of day the Web Site were visited, and other non-personally identifiable information. Anonymous information is information that is not tied to any individual.

3. Collection and Use of Personally Identifiable Information.

a. You can visit our Web Site without telling us who you are or revealing any personally identifiable information about yourself to us. It is only when you wish to receive additional services that we will require you to register with us by providing certain personally identifiable information and to select a user name and password. The Company will use personally identifiable information to:

- Welcome you to the Web Site.

- Send communications to you about the Web Site, including new features and services available through the Web Site.
- If you have consented beforehand, share with other users of the Web Site for purposes of completing your transaction, your name, e-mail address and telephone number, and allow them to contact you directly as necessary in connection with completing your transaction. PLEASE NOTE: The Web Site may not be used by anyone who is less than 18 years old, nor should anyone who is less than 18 years old share personally identifiable information with us or through the Web Site. We will not knowingly collect any personally identifiable information from anyone who is less than 18 years old.
- Verify your qualifications for receiving services we offer over the Web Site or for other programs or activities.

If you indicate to us that you do not want to receive certain types of communications at the time of registration, we will respect your wishes, and comply with your preferences; however, there may be cases where this will limit the Web Site services available to you.

Credit card transactions are transmitted by the Company to a financial gateway. We use Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) technology in an effort to protect the security of your credit card information; however, we do not guarantee the security of your credit card information.

4. **Sharing Personally Identifiable Information with Third Parties.**

If we share personally identifiable information with third parties that you have consented to, they may use the data we provide them (sometimes, in connection with other information they may have gathered about you), but are generally prohibited from sharing this information with other companies or people without your consent.

5. **Other Disclosures of Personally Identifiable Information.**

In certain special cases, we may disclose your personally identifiable information when we have reason to believe that disclosing this information is necessary to identify, contact or bring legal action against someone who may be causing injury to you, or otherwise injuring or interfering with the Company's rights, property or operations, other Web Site users, or anyone else who could be harmed by such activities or to enforce the Terms of Use Agreement. We may also disclose your personally identifiable information when we believe the law requires it, or in response to any demand by law enforcement authorities in connection with a criminal investigation, or civil or administrative authorities in connection with a pending civil case or administrative investigation.

6. **Anonymous Information.**

When you use the Web Site, we may collect anonymous information, even if you have not registered with the Company. We may use this information to examine how the Web Site is used or to help the Company improve the services it offers to users. The Company will not share any

anonymous information about your use of the Web Site with third parties if we know that this anonymous information will be linked by third parties with personally identifiable information of yours obtained from another source, unless we have given you notice as described above and you have given us authorization to do so.

7. **Cookies.**

A "cookie" is a small piece of data that is sent to your browser from a web server and stored on your computer's hard drive. Cookies are harmless bits of code that an Internet site assigns to your browser to keep track of who you are when you use the web site. There is no risk of the information on your hard drive being exposed to the outside world since a web site can only read the cookies it creates.

Cookies are sometimes used on the Internet to improve the delivery of services to users by enabling the Web Site to "customize" the particular services or information offered to each user.

The Company will employ and use cookies during your visits to the Web Site. Further, third parties will have their own policies about the use of cookies, and the Company does not have control over these practices. You are responsible for obtaining information about cookies on third-party web site if you believe this is important to know.

As a general rule, you can choose whether to accept cookies by changing the settings of your browser. You can reset your browser to refuse all cookies, or allow your browser to show you when a cookie is being sent. If you choose not to accept these cookies, your experience at our Web Site and other web site will be diminished and some features will not work as intended.

8. **Use of IP Addresses.**

An Internet Protocol (IP) address is a set of numbers that is assigned to your computer. Web servers - the powerful computers that provide web pages for viewing - automatically identify your computer by the IP address assigned to it during your session online.

The Company will collect IP addresses for purposes of system administration and to monitor and audit the use of the Web Site. We can and will use IP addresses to identify users of the Web Site when we feel it is necessary to enforce compliance with the Company's Terms of Use Agreement, or to protect our service, Web Site, or other users. We will not share or sell linked user behavior and personal user information with any third parties unless you have given us authorization to do so.

PLEASE NOTE: Under certain circumstances, IP addresses and/or domain names may be linked to personally identifiable information, when said information is stored in databases managed by Internet registrars or registries such as Network Solutions.

9. **Third Party Relationships.**

WEB SITE THAT ARE OPERATED OR MAINTAINED BY PERSONS OTHER THAN THE COMPANY ARE NOT COVERED BY THIS PRIVACY POLICY. Whenever you authorize the Company to share information about you with third parties, you are responsible for

determining whether the third party employs an acceptable privacy policy. The Company does not make this determination for you, and does not warrant that any particular third party maintains a privacy policy that is acceptable to you.

10. **Security.**

The Company currently leases server space, which we believe are secure data networks protected by industry standard procedures, in an attempt to protect against the loss, misuse and alteration of your personally identifiable information under our control; however, we do not guarantee the security any of your personally identifiable information and are not responsible for any failure of such security or misuse of your personally identifiable information.

Only authorized employees of the Company have access to the information you provide us. For example, we impose strict rules on employees who have access either to the databases that store user information or to the servers that host our services. While we cannot guarantee that loss, misuse or alteration to data will not occur, we will use reasonable effort (such as the use of employee passwords and non-disclosure agreements) to prevent such unfortunate occurrences.
